

**RESOLUTION DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY TO BE OF NO USE**

*THIS IS A RESOLUTION, PER OCGA 36-37-6(a) "SALE OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY", DECLARING PERSONAL PROPERTY CURRENTLY OWNED BY THE CITY OF MADISON, GEORGIA, TO BE OF NO USE TO THE CITY; AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SAID PERSONAL PROPERTY; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS OF RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.*

1. The City of Madison, Georgia, having acquired the personal property described below:

7. The City of Madison, Georgia reserves the right to cancel the sale, reject any and all bids, waive any technicalities or irregularities, sell the property in whole or in part, and to take any action based on the best interests of Madison, Georgia.

Per OCGA 36-37-6(b), City is authorized to sell personal property with estimated value of \$500 or less by direct sale, on the open market without advertisement and without the acceptance of bids, and such is hereby authorized for those items above which are personal property with estimated value of \$500 or less.

9. All resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

10. This resolution is deemed to be severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or part of this resolution shall for any reason be determined invalid, such determination shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this resolution, but shall be confined in its effect to such phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or part hereof directly involved in the determination.

11. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
