Pop Up Art Programs	Ann Dodys reported that the Mini Art Gallery was ready to be installed. The Gallery was on hand for all to inspect. Finishing touches will be made after installation followed by a ribbon cutting.
Building the Arts	Clare Wolfe had nothing new to report. She recounted the achievements and donations to date. It is anticipated that BI Production Works will be at the August meeting to hear the presentation.
