



2016 DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

CITY OF MADISON

To the City of Madison Residents *ONLY!*

The City of Madison and State of Georgia requires all dogs to be vaccinated against rabies. This must be done by a licensed veterinarian. The fine for your animal not being current on rabies vaccination is \$79.50.

The City of Madison also requires that all dogs be licensed *annually*.

The cost of the license is \$5.00 for a sterilized dog and \$15.00 for an unsterilized dog. Failure to have a dog license results in a fine of \$79.50 in addition to the \$79.50 fine for not being current on rabies vaccination. The deadline for licensing is July 1, 2016. After this date, there will be an additional \$5.00 penalty. The tag, when attached to the collar, also will allow Animal Control to identify your dog if it is ever picked up. This tag is in addition to the rabies tag issued by your veterinarian. You may obtain the City of Madison tag at:
